The Task

SFOFY stands for Street Food Opportunities for Youth.

It is an Erasmus+ KA2 Strategic Partnership for Youth funded by the Erasmus+ National Agency of France.

The project lasts 24 months from February 2018 till January 2020.

One of the Outputs of the SFOFY project is to generate an interactive / organic map of opportunities for present or prospective entrepreneurs in street food. Opportunities include festivals, funding and training opportunities, networks and incubation centres. It also includes good practices in street food and in its promotion of the business.

Google Maps

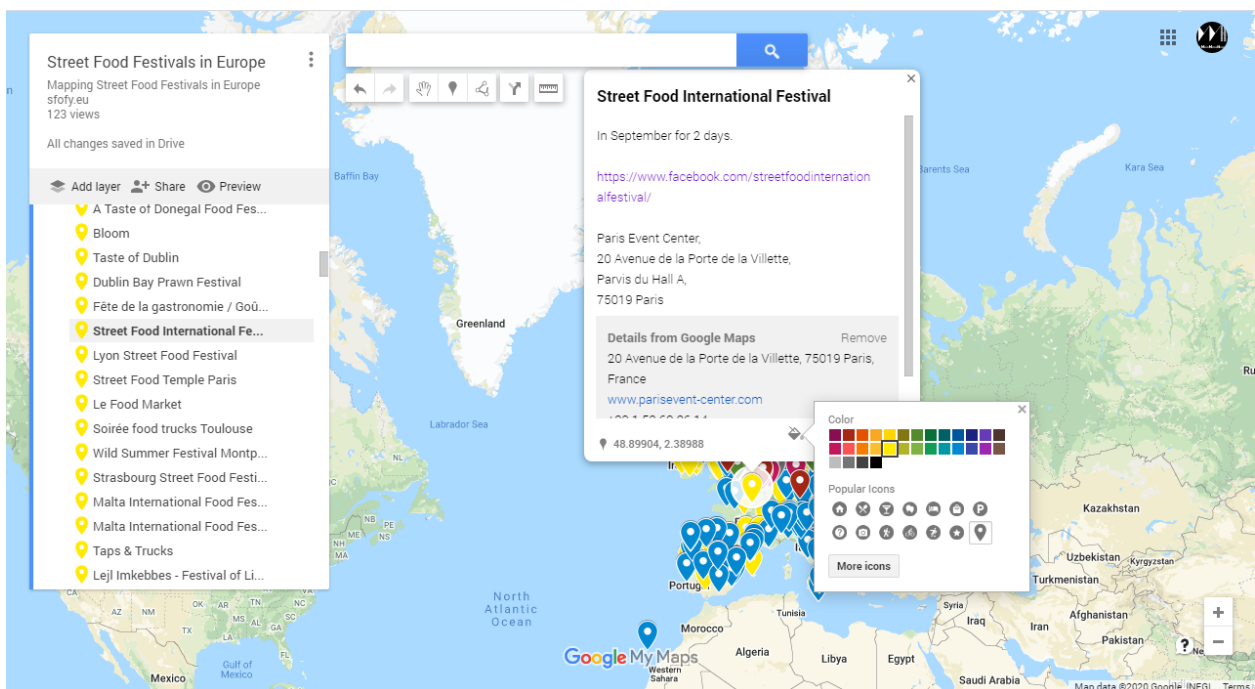
We decided to use Google Maps for the mapping activity since we knew that one can add multiple places and locations at the same time and that one can embed the map on a webpage and even on several web pages without the need of further administration from the part of the webmaster of such page/s. This means flexibility, autonomy and distance cooperation with ease even beyond the project lifetime.

One first needs to have a gmail account so that one can save own maps etc. as will be explained further down.

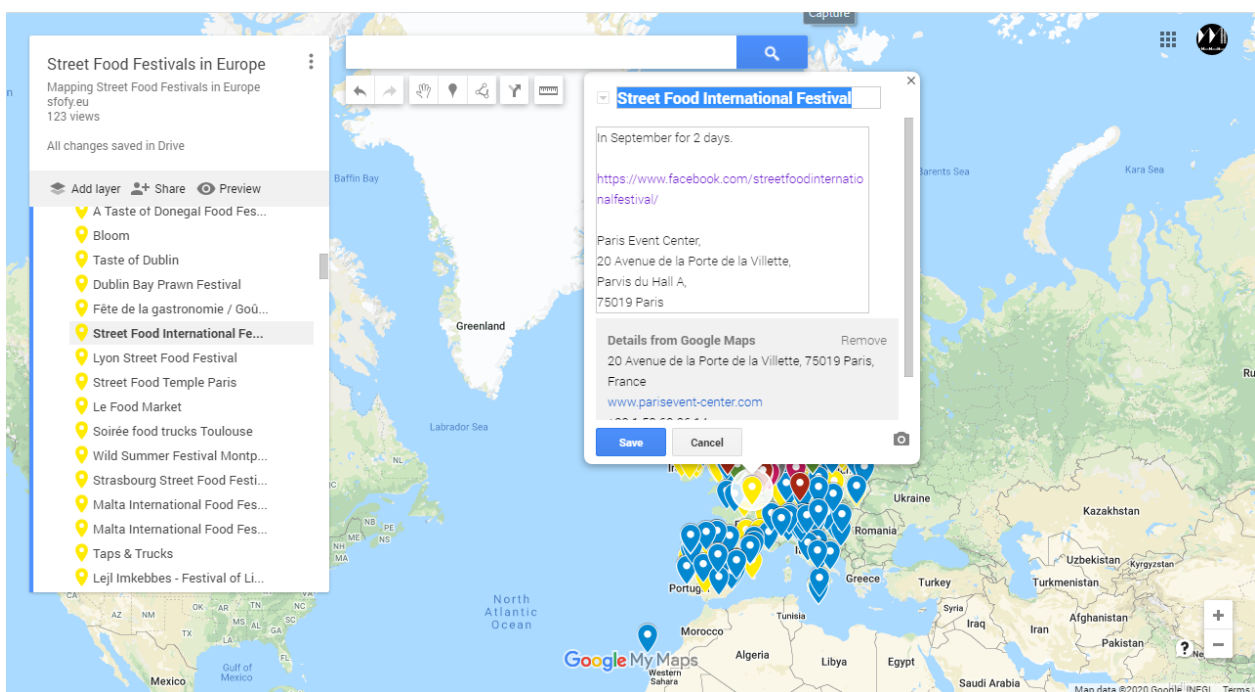
One logs in on the gmail account and opens Google Maps in the internet browser.

One opens the menu of Google Maps and will see different options on the left hand side menu. One clicks on "Your places" and this will open a new menu. In this menu one needs to click on "MAPS". At the bottom of the menu one can click on "CREATE A MAP". This will open a new web page in the browser.

A new menu appears and one can see "Untitled Layer" and one can change the name of the layer to a new name. Now one can start to search for the address or place, like one uses Google Maps normally. One enters an address, then clicks on "Add to map". One will see different icons for "Style", "Edit", "Add image or video", "Directions to here" and "Delete feature". In "Style" one can edit the colour of the marked spot and also the icon. In "Edit" one can change the description. For example if one wishes to add a festival, one will probably have an address. One types the address and add to a map and if one clicks on the icon one will just see the address. Then one edits and types in the name of the festival instead of the address as a title to that item on the map. Under the title one can add more information.



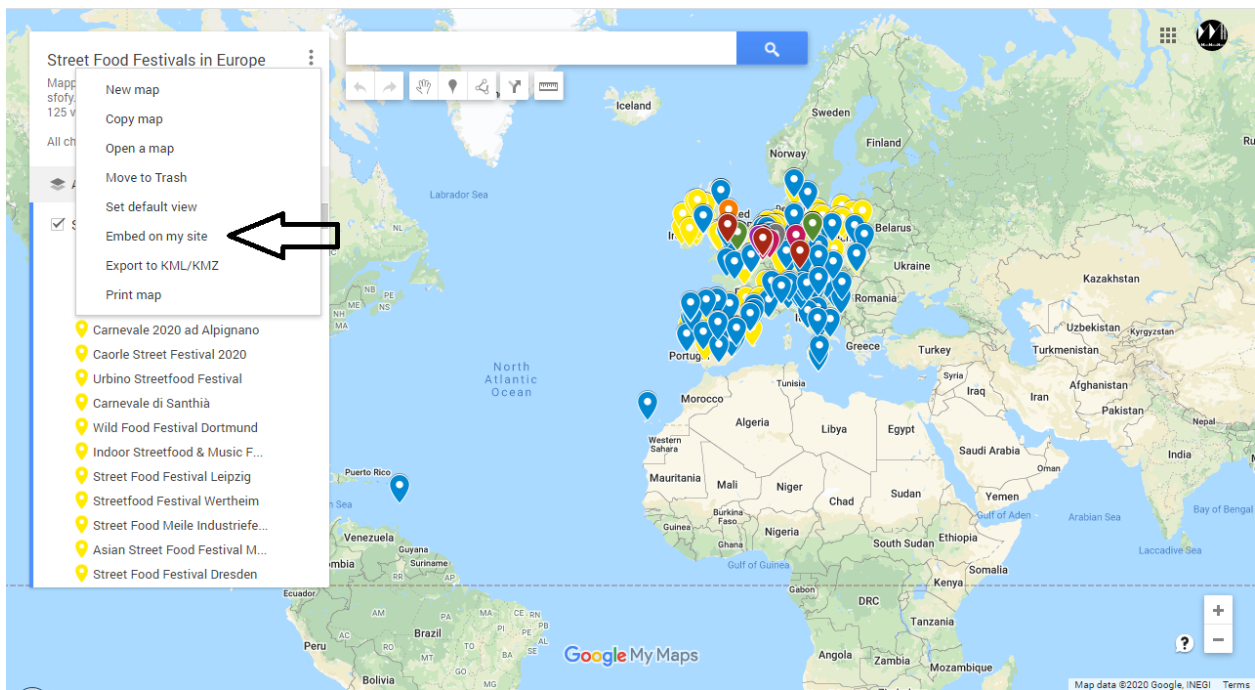
Google Maps allows to change the colour and icon of the placed marker.



One can change the title and description of the chosen address.

One can find the HTML code to embed in the menu of the left sided toolbar. The map can be embedded in any web page by going to "Share" and obtain the HTML code that one needs to copy and paste on the web page source code.

One can also not embed but make a link from any web page or email or offline pdf document and when one clicks on the link the computer or mobile device opens an internet browser with the SFOFY map.



Google Maps provides users to embed the map on websites.

Mapping

Once one is conversant with Google Maps one has to think about the question “Which information are we going to put on the map?”.

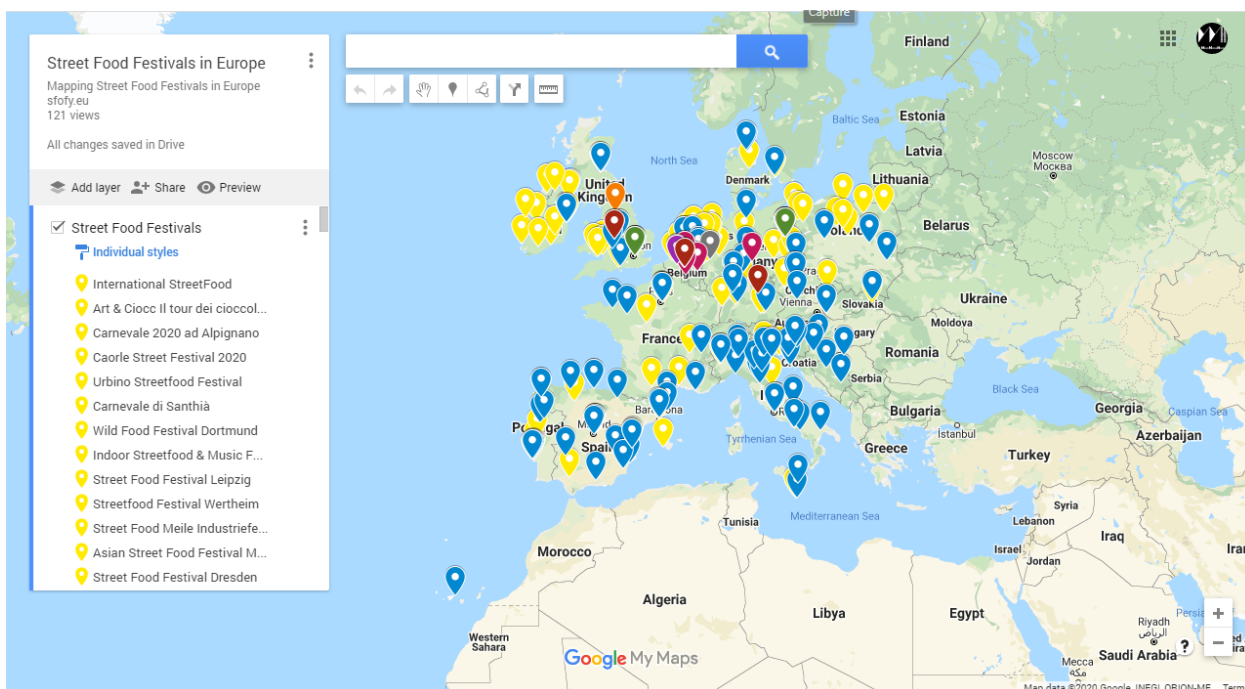
Since the subject is street food we wanted to start with the street food festivals in Europe. We started an Excel sheet with columns with “Name of Festival”, “Address”, “Approximate Traffic”, “Time of Year”, “Website” and “Duration”.

We started with the countries in which we have partners and those, which languages are spoken in the partnership. After we could find out the information we needed, we started to search in Google Maps and created a layer. We used yellow for the street food festivals since we wanted to have a link to the project logo. In the next step we changed the title. We used the name of the festival instead of the address. We put all the other information in the description below.

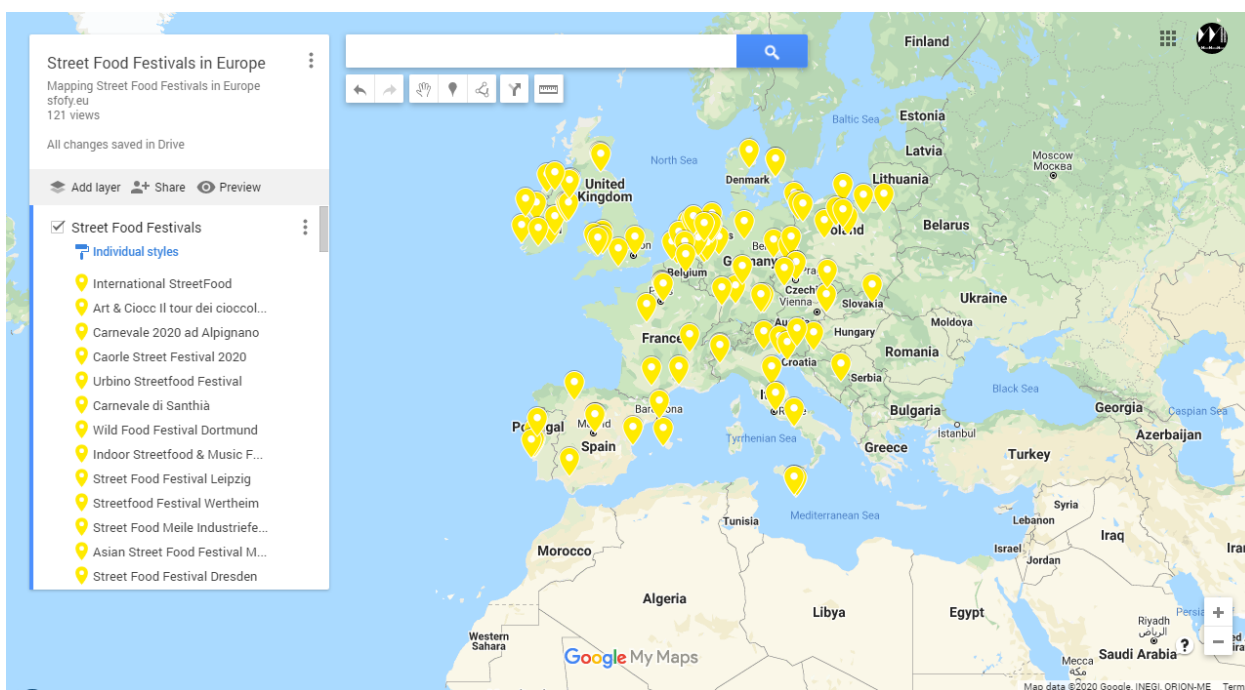
In the second step of the mapping we searched for information about “Good Practices”, “Financing Opportunities”, “Food Networks”, “Food Incubators”, “Food and Catering Training” and “Street Food Network”. We used the same system as we used for the festivals. We started with the list of the partner countries and those, whose languages we are able to speak.

During this step we had the idea that we could add “Training opportunities”. The idea came since we know about the project “Erasmus for Young Entrepreneurs (EYE)”. So we added the intermediary organisations in each country on the map in a different layer. We chose blue as a link to the European Union.

After this step, we started to add “Training and Catering Training” in orange, “Good Practices” in grey, “Financing Opportunities” in dark pink, “Food Networks” in purple, “Food Incubators” in green and “Street Food Networks” in bordeaux. We chose different colours and layers to classify the different subjects in order to find them easier on the map.



This is the created map including all the information.



This is the map in which only the street food festivals in Europe are shown. One can filter this map on the required criteria which were already put in, for example good practices, financing opportunities etc. .

Partners and other persons or organisations in street food have the opportunity to add more entries in the map by filling in the form <https://forms.gle/e7j9Kk3JJ7H6i2gZ9> and we will update the map accordingly periodically checking if there are new entries using the form.

Content has been generated during the project lifetime as follows but entries on the map will continue to be collected even beyond the project lifetime.

Challenges

Of course we had some language related challenges in countries with languages we are not able to speak. We used the translation option of the browser.

Another challenge was that we could not find the addresses straightaway and we had to do some detailed search. Sometimes these were simple cases like putting a space or adding or removing a comma or the number of the building could not be found.

We have overcome some of these challenges by asking partners for their input and since they all know their field in their territory they were able to help us add entries to the map. They can still do this even after the project funded lifetime has ended.

Extended Cooperation

We tried to keep the map as understandable as possible with as much information as we could find and also that it is extendable with further or new information.

Extension is possible for the SFOFY project because more entries can be added to the map as we go along even beyond the project lifetime. Entries can be suggested by the visitors to the project website where there is a link to a form suggesting more entries to the map.

It is also a good platform to use the map to foster networking with strategies like “List your festival here” so that the project may be seen as a good platform for networking and seeking of opportunities. This process was started during the project lifetime and it will be one of the strategies during exploitation efforts.

Emulation of Process Potential

The use of such mapping is apt for a number of youth activities and indeed for other training and learning or cooperation opportunities.

One can have a gmail account linked to a project, for example, and participants in a cooperative exercise can add entries to a joint map. This has challenges due to homogeneity of the entries so there needs to be some solid guidelines to follow or a central editor to correct entries. This cooperation can be implemented remotely in a very easy way since Google Maps are available once one is linked to the internet.

It is possible in class for joint research projects if the pins on the map represent findings.

Examples of use of Google Maps for mapping are:

- pins on a Google Map to trace the whereabouts of a sea turtle that has a sensor with GPS attached to its shell,
- pins to show location of blood donation trucks,
- pins on a map to show location of vans used by banks to extend their services to remote villages where they have no branch and
- pins to show location of mobile information kiosks.

Some maps can be static and with periodical updates and some can change content dynamically if content needs more major updates.

If used in a learning environment such cooperative work can be part of a lesson plan to foster cooperation and some autonomy, group responsibility and flexible learning. It can be used to foster leadership in case one or more members in a group is editor or lays the rules for posting. It can be part of larger or wider training as in:

- research or joint research,
- social media strategies,
- networking and community building,
- marketing strategies and
- culture / education / food / campaigns related projects.
